Payment Details:

\$78 per team for the DI membership itself (includes program materials -including the Road Map that is a day by day, detailed DI curriculum for team managers that prefer that type of structure - it teaches creativity, problem solving and teamwork skills), and allows one team of 2-7 kids to participate in a DI tournament.
